Tower Silo Permits Require:

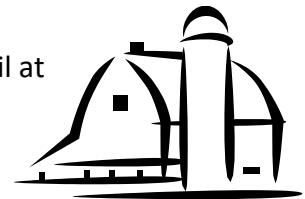
- A completed permit application form** including name, address and phone number of owner and contractor, estimated project cost, signature and date. Under purpose of work please note the type of silo (poured concrete or stave).
- A plot plan, site plan or survey** of the property indicating the location of the proposed silo in relation to existing structures, existing silos, septic tank and bed, and property lines.
- Two sets of construction/erection drawings** including the diameter and height of the silo, footing and foundation details, structural drawings including any steel reinforcing placement schedules. The drawings shall be prepared and stamped by a Professional Engineer where:
 - The silo height exceeds 4 times its diameter. For example, a silo 18' in diameter can be 72' high.
 - The proposed silo is closer than half its diameter to an existing silo.
- List what is being stored in the silo** i.e. high moisture corn, silage, haylage, etc.
- Note the soil type in the proposed location**

Permits are completed in the order that they are received and take approximately 15 business days to process. You will be notified if any questions arise and/or when the permit is issued and available for pick-up.

Once your permit is issued it is the owners/contractors responsibility to ensure a Township Building Official inspects the work. Typically the following inspections are required for a silo; an excavation inspection of the footings prior to pouring concrete, a foundation inspection prior to backfill and a final inspection of the structure.
