

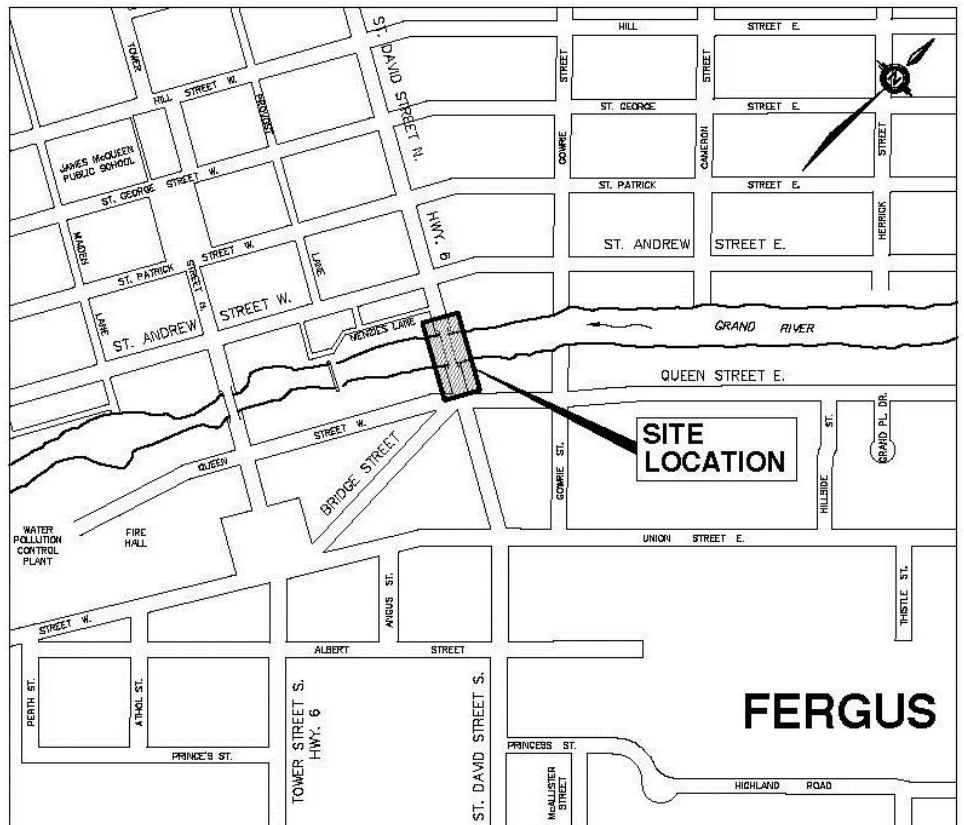

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE NO. 2

### CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT ST DAVID STREET BRIDGE (STRUCTURE 2-F) REHABILITATION ST. DAVID STREET (Highway No. 6) OVER GRAND RIVER, FERGUS MTO SITE NO. 35-210

The Township of Centre Wellington (Township) is progressing with the Environmental Assessment Study for the St. David Street Bridge (Structure 2-F) located on St. David Street (Highway No. 6) crossing over the Grand River in Fergus. The Bridge was constructed in 1968, and is nearing the end of its service life. The rehabilitation of the St. David Street Bridge will include the replacement of the deck, girders and traffic barriers, modification of the abutments to semi-integral type complete with new waterproofing and paving, road approaches, drainage improvements and utility replacement. In April 2016, the Township was successful in securing a \$2.2 million grant for the rehabilitation of the St. David Street Bridge under the Province of Ontario's Connecting Links Program. The St. David Street Bridge rehabilitation is scheduled to occur in 2018 with utility relocations occurring in late 2016 and 2017.



#### The Process:

This project is being planned in accordance with the requirements of a Schedule "B" project under the "Municipal Class Environmental Assessment" (Municipal Engineers Association, June 2000 as amended in 2007 & 2011) which is an approved process under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act. The Class Environmental Assessment process includes public and agency consultation, an evaluation of alternatives, an assessment of potential environmental effects, and identification of reasonable measures to mitigate any adverse impacts that may result. Public Information Centre No. 1 was held on October 6, 2016 to introduce the study include the existing environmental conditions, review the rehabilitation alternatives considered.

#### How to Participate:

The purpose of Public Information Centre No. 2 is to report the study progress, present the preliminary preferred rehabilitation alternative and provide an opportunity for public and agency to review and

comment. You are encouraged to attend this Public Information Centre and provide your comments so that they may be included in the study. Public Information Centre No. 2 is scheduled for:
