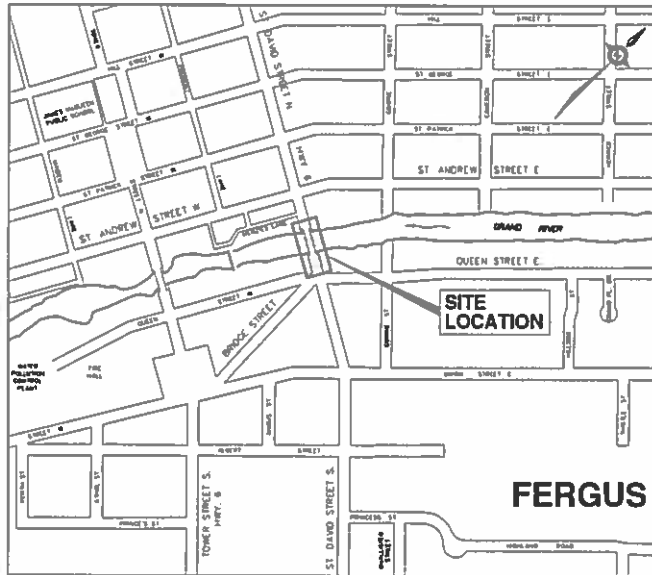
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**PUBLIC COMMENT INVITED**

The Township of Centre Wellington (Township) is planning the rehabilitation of Structure 2-F located on St. David Street (Highway No. 6) crossing over the Grand River in Fergus. The Bridge was constructed in 1968, and is nearing the end of its service life. The rehabilitation of the St. David Street Bridge will include the replacement of the deck, girders and traffic barriers, modification of the abutments to semi-integral type complete with new waterproofing and paving, road approaches, drainage improvements and utility replacement. In April 2016, the Township was successful in securing a \$2.2 million grant for the rehabilitation of the St. David Street Bridge under the Province of Ontario's Connecting Links Program.

**The Process:**

This project is being planned in accordance with the requirements of a Schedule "B" project under the "Municipal Class Environmental Assessment" (Municipal Engineers Association, June 2000 as amended in 2007 & 2011) which is an approved process under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act. The Class Environmental Assessment process includes public and agency consultation, an evaluation of alternatives, an assessment of potential environmental effects, and identification of reasonable measures to mitigate any adverse impacts that may result.



**How to Participate:**

Public and agency consultation is a key component of this project. A Public Information Centre regarding this project is planned for the fall of 2016. This Public Information Centre will provide the public and agencies the opportunity to review the rehabilitation alternatives considered and to discuss any questions or concerns relating to this project with the Project Team. The Project Team is comprised of Township staff, Triton Engineering (Project Management) and MMM Group/WSP (Bridge Design).
