Stick & Puck

This self-taught stick and puck program allows for a relaxed atmosphere to help develop hockey (or Ringette) skills at your own pace, in a comfortable setting. Work on stick handling, shooting and skating skills. No scrimmages/games, slap shots or body contact allowed.

CSA approved helmets are required for all participants. Full equipment is recommended.

Family Stick & Puck – This program is not supervised by a skate patrol. Children 9 years and younger, must be supervised on ice, by a parent/guardian who is at least 12 years of age with sufficient skating ability. A parent/guardian is required to be in the facility for the duration of the skate.

Family Skating

This skating time is designed for families to skate in a quiet, relaxed atmosphere. This skating time is ideal for younger children and those needing a controlled and comfortable place to work on skating skills and enjoy time with family. This program is not supervised by a skate patrol. Children 9 years and younger, must be supervised on ice, by a parent/guardian who is at least 12 years of age with sufficient skating ability.

CSA approved helmets must be worn by all children and are encouraged for adults.

Adult & Senior Skating

The perfect time to skate if you're over the age of 18. Skate at your leisure to some background music from the 60's, 70's, 80's and 90's. No pucks or sticks allowed. CSA approved helmets are recommended for all participants.

Public Skating

Public skating is open to all ages and abilities. Strollers are not permitted on the ice during public skating. Children 9 years and younger, must be supervised on ice, by a parent/guardian who is at least 12 years of age with sufficient skating ability. Proof of vaccination is required for everyone 12 years of age and over.

CSA approved helmets are required for all participants in Stick & Puck Programs. CSA approved helmets are highly recommended for all children, youth and adults in ice programs.

Participants may arrive up to 20 minutes prior to their registered ice time. Participants must leave within 20 minutes of their program end time. Participants must wear a face covering throughout the facility and in dressing rooms. Face coverings may be removed while on the ice. Participants must follow physical distancing protocols, rules posted in the facility and all signage and direction from staff. Failure to comply with facility rules, provincial and public health requirements, may result in the cancellation of programs.
