Stick & Puck

Family Stick & Puck – Families with children of all ages

Adult/Senior Stick & Puck – Adults 18+

This self-taught stick and puck program allows for a relaxed atmosphere to help develop hockey (or ringette) skills at your own pace, in a comfortable setting. Work on stick handling, shooting and skating skills. No scrimmages/games, slap shots or body contact allowed.

CSA approved helmets are required for all participants. Full equipment is recommended.

One parent/guardian is required to stay onsite and provide supervision from the designated viewing area for children who are 12 years and under.

A parent/guardian must be on the ice with their tot (under 6) at all times.

Family Skating

This public style skate is designed for families to skate in a quiet, relaxed atmosphere. This skating time is ideal for younger children and those needing a controlled and comfortable place to work on skating skills and enjoy time with family. CSA approved helmets must be worn by all children and are encouraged for adults. In order to ensure we do not exceed capacity limits, all parents and children must register for the program if they plan to skate on the ice.

Adult & Senior Skating

The perfect time to skate if you're over the age of 18. Skate at your leisure to some background music from the 60's, 70's, 80's and 90's. No pucks or sticks allowed. CSA approved helmets are recommended for all participants.

CSA approved helmets are required for all participants in Stick & Puck Programs. CSA approved helmets are highly recommended for all children, youth and adults in ice programs.

To ensure we do not exceed capacity limits and physical distancing can be maintained; all parents and children must register for the program if they plan to skate on the ice.

Dressing room capacities are limited. Participants may arrive up to 20 minutes prior to their registered ice time. Participants must leave within 20 minutes of their program end time.

Participants must wear a face covering throughout the facility. Face coverings may be removed while on the ice. Participants must follow physical distancing protocols, rules posted in the facility and all signage and direction from staff. Failure to comply with facility rules, provincial and public health requirements, may result in the cancellation of programs.
