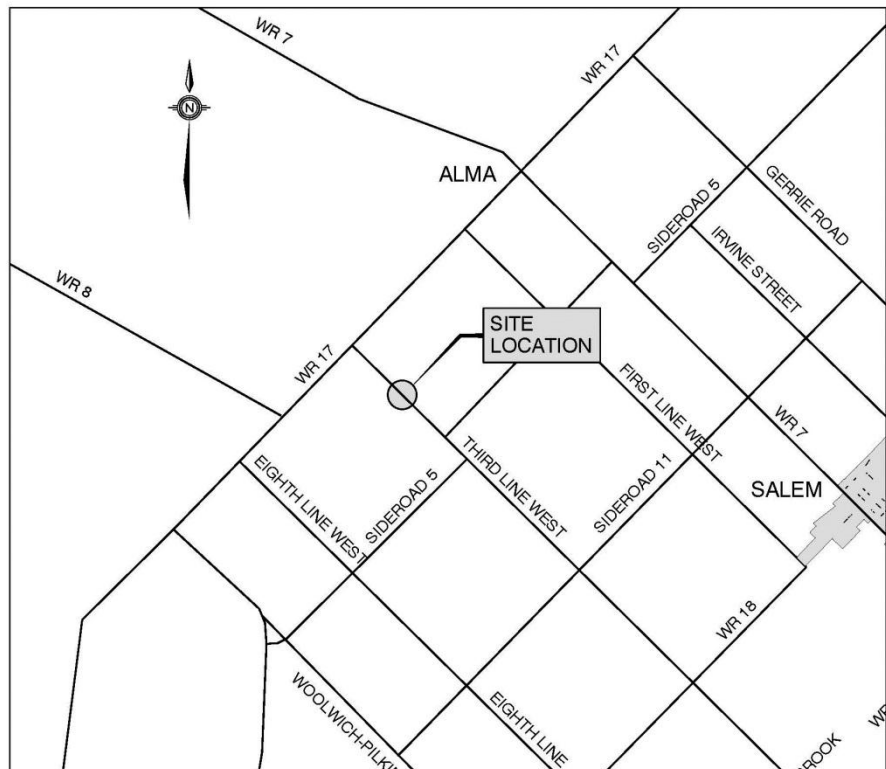
### CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT RECONSTRUCTION OF STRUCTURE 24-P 3<sup>RD</sup> LINE WEST AT CARROLL CREEK LOT 3, CONCESSIONS 3 & 4 FORMER TOWNSHIP OF PILKINGTON MTO SITE NO. 35-188

#### NOTICE OF COMPLETION

The Township of Centre Wellington has conducted a Class Environmental Assessment (EA) study for the reconstruction of Structure 24-P, a concrete girder bridge located on Third Line West at Carroll Creek, Lot 3, Concessions 3 & 4, former Township of Pilkington. Built in 1930, the bridge has reached the end of its service life and is now closed for public use. This Class EA study considers options and identifies the preferred alternative to address the deterioration of the bridge.

#### The Process

This Class EA study is being conducted in accordance with the requirements of a Schedule "B" study under the "Municipal Class Environmental Assessment" (Municipal Engineers Association, June 2000 as amended in 2007) which is an approved process under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act. The Class Environmental Assessment process includes public and agency consultation, an evaluation of alternatives, an assessment of potential environmental effects, and identification of reasonable measures to mitigate any adverse impacts that may result.



## Preferred Alternative

Subject to comments received as a result of this Notice, and the receipt of the necessary approvals, the Township of Centre Wellington intends to proceed with the design and construction of Alternative 3 which is the removal of the existing bridge and construction of a new concrete girder bridge in the same location.
