SUMMER STUDENT EMPLOYMENT
(FULL TIME HOURS, MAY TO AUGUST 2023)

The Township of Centre Wellington's Infrastructure Services Department and Parks and Recreation Department are now accepting applications from qualified secondary and post-secondary students for summer work positions in our Roads, Environmental Services and Parks Divisions.

Work will require the operation of small hand tools, ride on equipment and hand operated weed trimmers in lawn and green space maintenance; as well as labour work, as required, in a mainly outdoor environment.

Expected hours of work include a forty-hour week from Monday through Friday. (Parks & Recreation student position includes a rotating weekend shift)

Previous experience in the operation of mowers, weed trimmers and landscaping is an asset; however, training will be provided. Candidates must possess good communication skills, both written and verbal, and have the ability to interact with the public in a courteous and effective manner. The capability to perform physical tasks are a requirement of the position.

A minimum G2 Driver's license is required.

All applicants must be enrolled in full time secondary or post-secondary school for September 2023 to be eligible.

Hourly rates of pay range from \$16.21 to \$17.87 per hour (2023 rates)
