Parent Information: March Break Day Camp

Welcome to a fun-filled week at camp, where every day is a new adventure. We are so excited to welcome your child to our camp! This is a brief outline of what we will be doing from day to day. The March Break Day Camp program operates at the Centre Wellington Community Sportsplex in Gord Brown Hall and at the Jefferson Elora Community Centre. There will be plenty of outdoor activities (weather permitting), crafts, active games, ice skating. Children are supervised during pick up and drop off times. Day camp activities are planned from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm. Our leader to participant ratio is a minimum of 1:8.

All Program Staff have been selected and trained to work with your child(ren). In addition to our day camp leaders, we will have Leaders-in-training assisting with camp.

Activities may include: talent show, scavenger hunts, crafts, charades, board/ card games, musical games (freeze dance, musical chairs), sports (dodgeball, soccer, hand ball, basketball etc), trips outside to the park and many camp favourite games (who snatched the bacon, everyone is it tag, capture the flag and more).
