Economic Development is responsible for the following:

- Encourage and facilitate business retention, expansion, and attraction:
- Promote and market the sale of land in the Centre Wellington Business Park;
- Promote and administer the Community Improvement Plan to encourage new development and investments;
- Collaborate with key stakeholders such as BIA's, Chamber of Commerce, Wellington Waterloo Community Futures, and the Wellington Federation of Agriculture;
- Provide economic and community information demographics and statistics to promote Centre Wellington; and,
- Navigate funding programs and business support resources for start-ups.
