The Township of Centre Wellington's Community Services Department is now accepting applications from qualified candidates for the temporary part time positions of Assistant Instructor Guards, Swim Instructors, Lifeguards, and Aquafit Instructors at the Centre Wellington Community Sportsplex.

The Township is offering all required courses for positions in the near future. Candidates interested in applying without all of their certifications are welcome to do so and positions can be offered based on the successful completion of the required courses.

<u>Assistant Instructor Guard (AIG)</u>: Assist the instructor during the instructional program. Perform minor first aid and assist in emergencies as required. Represents the Township of Centre Wellington in a consistent, positive manner, through ownership of programs, facility and meeting customer service expectations.

Qualifications: Minimum requirement – Lifesaving Society Assistant Instructor certification, Bronze Cross.

<u>Swim Instructor</u>: Instruct assigned classes in accordance to the governing body's (Lifesaving Society) standards and the Township of Centre Wellington expectations. Represents the Township of Centre Wellington in a consistent, positive manner, through ownership of program, facility and meeting customer service expectations.

Qualifications: Minimum requirement – National Lifeguard or Lifesaving Society Swim instructor, Standard First Aid, CPR "C" all current within 2 years.

<u>Lifeguard</u>: Maintain and enforce high safety standards at all times. Lifeguard as requested and assume all responsibilities of a guard. Represents the Township of Centre Wellington in a consistent, positive manner, through ownership of programs, facility and meeting customer service expectations.

Qualifications: Minimum requirement – National Lifeguard, Standard First Aid, CPR "C" all current within 2 years.

<u>Aquafit Instructor</u>: Instruct assigned classes in accordance to the governing body's (WaterArt, CALA standards and the Township of Centre Wellington expectations. Represents the Township of Centre Wellington in a consistent, positive manner, through ownership of program, facility and meeting customer service expectations.

Qualifications: Minimum requirement – Aquafit Certification from a Nationally recognized provider (ie WaterArt, CALA, YMCA) current within 2 years.
